Khattar reviews Maharashtra, other states' cleanliness efforts

Mumbai, Aug 26 (UNI): Union Minister for Housing and Urban Development Manohar Lal Khattar today reviewed urban cleanliness programmes in various states through video conferencing.

Deputy Chief Minister Eknath Shinde, additional chief secretary of the Urban Development Department Asimkumar Gupta, principal secretary to the Deputy CM Nawin Sonu, and senior officials of the department attended the meeting. Through video conferencing, union Minister of State Tokhan Sahu, project director Rupa Mishra, and urban development ministers and principal secretaries of various states also interacted with the union minister.

Speaking on the occasion, Deputy CM Shinde said: "Prime Minister Narendra Modi launched the Swachh Bharat Abhiyan in October 2014, and because of the overwhelming public

response, the campaign has now turned into a mass movement. This cleanliness movement is ongoing in Maharashtra, and the 'Deep Clean Drive' campaign in Mumbai city and suburbs has given momentum to cleanliness. The state government is implementing several initiatives, such as Zero Waste Cities and beautification of public toilet premises.

On the lines of the Centre, the state is implementing Swachh Maharashtra Abhiyan (Urban) 2.0, under which the construction of individual and community toilets is progressing.

For 358 towns with populations under one lakh, sewage treatment projects with a capacity of 1,656 million liters per day have been proposed. Shinde said, adding that 200 sludge suction vehicles will be procured soon. He also stated that 10 projects for construction and demolition waste

management are being planned. Approval has been granted to 186 projects by urban local bodies for processing legacy waste, of which 108 have completed the work, and the remaining are ongoing, Shinde said.

At the Deonar dumping ground of the Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation, bio-mining of 18.5 million metric tons of waste is expected to be completed by December 2028. He further added that detailed project reports of 337 urban local bodies for solid waste management and 8 local bodies for wastewater management have been approved.

Maharashtra secured the first rank in the country in the Centre's Swachh Survekshan 2023, and in 2024, 10 cities from the state received awards. Out of these, seven cities were included in the Super Swachh League, for which union Minister Khattar congratulated Maharashtra, said Shinde.

Youth in Ratnagiri kills mother, attempts suicide amid financial woes

Kolhapur/Ratnagiri, Aug 26 (UNI): In a shocking incident at Shantinagar in Ratnagiri today, a youth allegedly murdered his mother before attempting to take his own life due to mounting financial stress, police said.

Police identified the accused as Aniket Teli, who was reportedly under severe pressure after failing to pay loan installments. In despair, he attacked his mother, Puja Shahikant Teli, with a sharp weapon, inflicting multiple blows that killed her on the spot.

Following the incident, Aniket attempted suicide by slashing his wrists. Neighbours, alerted by the commotion, rushed him to the hospital in a critical condition.

Police have registered the case and further investigation is underway.

Successful ascent of Mount Yunam by Giripremi Adventure Foundation.

Pune, Aug 26 (UNI): Five mountaineers from Pune-based Giripremi Adventure Foundation successfully summited Mount Yunam (6,111 meters) located in the Lahaul region of Himachal Pradesh. The expedition, organized by the Giripremi Adventure Foundation, included a total of eight members. The team was led by Giripremi mountaineer Mihir Jadhav. Along with

Mihir, Shrikant Nistane, Rahul Satav, Dhannaj Mohze, and Dr. Avnish Anshul hoisted the Indian national flag on the summit on 15th August, commemorating India's 79th Independence Day. Among the other expedition members, Subodh Sonani climbed up to an altitude of 4,800 meters, while Milind Mahajan, Satish Aware, and Iqbal Singh reached up to 4,200 meters, said the release. To climb this peak above 6,000 meters in the Lahaul region, all members underwent extensive physical and mental preparation for several months. Training in the rugged terrain of the Sakyaadi Mountain

beneficial during the climb. Schools in hilly and difficult terrain areas must maintain at least 20 students in the highest class. Other areas require minimum 30 students, with all eligible students needing verified Aadhaar academic year recognition.

RTMNU to build tribal history museum with Rs 44.70 cr project

Nagpur, Aug 26 (UNI): Rashtrasant Tukadoji Maharaj Nagpur University (RTMNU) will soon build a landmark Tribal History Museum, showcasing the rich culture and heritage of Maharashtra's tribal communities.

The Public Works Department (PWD) has sanctioned the project at a cost of Rs 44.70 crore, of which Rs 37.57 crore is earmarked for construction. The museum is expected to be completed within nine months, including the monsoon period.

Spread across a three-storey RCC building of nearly 40,000 sq. ft., the

facility will feature exhibition halls, digital display galleries, seminar and research rooms, an auditorium, archival storage, landscaped gardens, parking and barrier-free access. The structure will also adhere to earthquake-resistant norms.

Artefacts, manuscripts, dioramas, and digital installations will present these themes, with interactive elements designed to engage younger audiences.

The museum will also document the histories of tribes including Gond, Madia, Kolam, Halba, and

Election Commission issues Show-Cause Notice to Panthers Republican Party

Ch. Sambhajnagar, Aug 26 (UNI): The Election Commission of India has issued a show-cause notice to the Panthers Republican Party, seeking an explanation for its proposed removal from the list of registered political parties due to prolonged inactivity.

The notice cites Section 29A of the Representation of the People Act, 1951, under which the party was originally registered.

According to a press release issued by the DIO, official records indicate the party has failed to contest any elections - including

Lok Sabha polls, state legislative assembly elections, or by-elections - over the past six years, constituting a failure to function as per registration requirements. The Election Commission, exercising powers under Article 324 of the Constitution alongside Section 29A of the Act, has consequently proposed deregistration proceedings unless satisfactory justification is provided.

The party has been directed to submit a written explanation accompanied by an affidavit from its president or general secretary, along with all

supporting documents, to the Joint Chief Electoral Officer by September 4, 2025. A hearing is scheduled for September 11, 2025, at the Chief Electoral Officer's office, Mumbai, where mandatory attendance of the party president or general secretary is required. The commission clarified that failure to respond by the stipulated date will be construed as having no representation in the matter, leading to appropriate action without further communication. The notice was formally communicated through the Joint Chief Electoral Officer's office.

Congress to visit flood-affected areas of Nanded

Mumbai, Aug 26 (UNI): A Maharashtra Congress delegation will visit the flood-hit areas of Nanded district on August 28 to assess the damage caused by heavy rainfall.

The committee, formed on the directive of state Congress president Harshvardhan Sapkal, will visit Mukhed taluka.

The 11-member delegation is headed by Congress Working Committee member and Goa in-charge Manikrao Thakre.

Its members are Nanded MP Ravindra Chavan, former MP Tukaram Renge Patil, Nanded South Rural Hanmanrao Belmorekar, Nanded North Rural

District Congress president Rajesh Pawde, state vice-president Yashpal Bhinge, general secretary Dr. Dinesh Nakshate, Advocate Surendra Ghodajkar, Shrawan Rapanwad, Rekha Chavan and secretary Dhannaj Rathod.

Farmers in the district have suffered huge losses with standing crops destroyed by the recent downpour.

The delegation will submit a report to the state Congress, which will take up the matter with the government to ensure that compensation is provided to the flood victims.

Mumbai police gives clean chit to Nawab Malik

Mumbai, Aug 26 (UNI): Mumbai police have given a clean chit to NCP leader Nawab Malik in the defamation and stalking complaint filed by Yasmeen Wankhede, sister of former Narcotics Control Bureau zonal director Sameer Wankhede. Malik, however, declined to comment today, saying that the matter is sub judice. In a report recently submitted before the Metropolitan Magistrate Court in Andheri, the Amboli police, which were investigating the case as per court directions, found no evidence against Malik.

The report was filed in response to the complaint by Yasmeen, a lawyer by profession, after the court issued a show-cause notice over the delay in submission. The court will take the report on record before passing an order. In January this year, the magistrate's court had instructed the police to probe the allegations and file a report. In his statement, Malik maintained that his posts and press conferences were part of his responsibility as a spokesperson of a political party. He further clarified that he bore no personal animosity towards Yasmeen, adding that he has great respect for women and has never acted in any manner that would insult or disrespect them.

Rohini Khadse to face probe over evidence tampering allegations in rave party case

Pune, Aug 26 (UNI): Rohini Khadse, wife of accused Pranjal Khewalkar and daughter-in-law of former Maharashtra minister Eknath Khadse, is facing serious allegations of tampering with crucial evidence in the ongoing rave party case. According to reports, the charges pertain to alleged manipulation of key data found on Khewalkar's mobile phone, which is a significant part of the investigation. "Authorities are examining the claims, and a formal police case could also be registered depending on the findings,"
