Bihar CM Nitish Kumar lays foundation, inaugurates projects worth Rs 558.35 crore in Siwan

Patna, Sept 7 (UNI) Bihar Chief Minister Nitish Kumar today laid the foundation stone and inaugurated nine development projects worth Rs 558.35 crore in Siwan district.

Kumar initiated projects including construction of a 220/132/33 KV grid substation at Maivra and associated line bays costing Rs 222.01 crore, widening of Pachrukhi Bypass from Mohammadpur Mor (NH-531) to Chhapra-Tedhi Ghat-Gopalpur (NH-227) road costing Rs 120.48 crore and construction of a rail overbridge on State Highway 89 (Babunia-Siwan Road) at level crossing No. 91 SPL between Siwan railway station and Pachrukhi railway station, costing Rs 92.16 crore. The Chief Minister also inaugurated widening of Siwan-Andar Road costing Rs 67.47 crore, the widening of Bhanupokhar-Jiradei road via Janapur Bazar at Rs 18.26 crore, the construction of a 33/11 KV power substation at Sonkara, Andar at Rs 10.12 crore, the construction of a 33/11 KV power substation at Madhopur, Maharajanjan at Rs 9.93 crore, stringing of the second circuit of Mashrak-Maharajanjan 132 KV transmission line and associated line bays at Rs 9.43 crore and installation of an 80 MVA transformer at Siwan Grid Substation at Rs 8.49 crore.

During the programme, the Chief Minister also interacted with a large number of pension beneficiaries, Jeevika Didis, and other beneficiaries in Pachrukhi in Siwan.

CAG pulls up Mizoram over abandoned Export-Import training centre

Aizawl, Sept 7 (UNI) : Mizoram's ambitious plan to establish an Export Import Business Training Centre (EIBC) at Zungthang has turned into a glaring example of financial mismanagement, with the Comptroller and Auditor General of India (CAG) criticising the state for spending Rs 4.39 crore on a project that remains incomplete even after more than a decade.

The centre was first proposed in 2010 under the Ministry of Commerce and Industry's ASIDE scheme, with the State Level Export Promotion Committee (SLEPC), headed by the chief secretary, tasked with implementing it. It was envisioned as a hub to provide entrepreneurs and students with specialised training in export-import operations, marketing strategies and quality control—a much-needed boost to the state's fragile economy.

But the CAG's performance audit paints a bleak picture. In June 2012, the Project Director of the Export Promotional Industrial Park Authority appointed a consultant firm within just two days, ignoring Rule 150 of the General Financial Rules, 2005, which requires open tendering. The consultancy, for a fee of Rs 30 lakh, estimated the project at Rs 6.25 crore, but crucially set no timeline for completion. Construction

formally commenced in November 2012, and SLFPC allocated Rs 4.39 crore for the work. By October 2016, however, the entire amount had been spent, with the building only 70 per cent complete. The situation further deteriorated in 2015 when the Centre withdrew ASIDE from its budgetary support, leaving states to finance unfinished projects on their own.

The Bamboo Development Agency (BDA) sought Rs 2.21 crore in 2016 to bridge the shortfall, and later approached the North Eastern Council in 2022 and 2024 with requests amounting to Rs 3.11 crore. Yet, despite repeated appeals, the state government took no concrete action to mobilise funds. As a result, the EIBC project has been at a standstill for nearly nine years. The half-built structure at Zungthang not only symbolises wasted public money but also represents lost opportunities for entrepreneurs and young people who were supposed to benefit from its training programmes.

The audit concluded that the project was marred by irregular appointment of consultants, violation of tender norms, mismanagement of funds and failure to secure additional resources after ASIDE support was withdrawn.

Congress slams PM Manupur visit plan as 'insulting'

New Delhi, Sept 7 (UNI) The Congress today criticised Prime Minister Narendra Modi's likely visit to Manipur on September 13, calling it a "non-visit" and an "insult" to the people of the state.

In a post on X, Congress general secretary Jairam Ramesh called the proposed visit as a "rushed trip," which only reveals his callousness and insensitivity towards the people of Manipur.

"The proposed visit of the Prime Minister to Manipur on Sept 13 is being hailed by his cheerleaders. But it appears that he will be spending just about three hours, yes, just three hours in the state," Ramesh said. "This is actually an insult to the people of the state who have waited for him for 29 long and agonising months," the Rajya Sabha MP said.

Over 10 lakh youth to participate in 'NaMo Yuva Run' campaign to mark Modi's birthday

New Delhi, Sept 7 (UNI) The Bharatiya Janata Yuva Morcha (BJYM) today announced the launch of the 'NaMo Yuva Run'—For a Nasha Mukta Bharat, a nationwide youth mobilisation and fitness campaign aimed at promoting a drug-free India.

The initiative forms a part of the annual Seva Pakhwada (September 17 to October 2). The campaign, being organised to mark Prime Minister Narendra Modi's birthday on September 17, is expected to engage over 10 lakh young participants across 100 locations in the country.

The campaign was formally launched here by Tejvati Surya, National President of BJYM and Member of Parliament from Bangalore South, in the presence of Union Minister for Youth Affairs and

Sports, Mansukh Mandaviya, and fitness advocate Milind Soman, who has been appointed the National Run Ambassador for the event.

As part of the launch ceremony, the official campaign logo, mascot, T-shirt, and registration portal (www.namoyuvan.com) were unveiled. BJYM officials said the event symbolises a broader youth movement that integrates fitness, civic responsibility, and substance abuse awareness under a common platform.

"Fitness is the foundation of a strong nation," said Mandaviya, noting that youth-led initiatives such as the NaMo Yuva Run serve to "encourage a lifestyle rooted in discipline and wellbeing, which are essential for national development." The event is scheduled

to culminate on September 21, when BJYM will coordinate 100 simultaneous runs across urban and semi-urban centres. Each event is expected to draw a minimum of 10,000 participants, making it one of the largest coordinated youth fitness campaigns undertaken by a political youth wing in India.

Addressing the gathering, Tejvati Surya said the run is intended not merely as a fitness activity, but as a youth mobilisation strategy aligned with the broader vision of a Viksit Bharat by 2047, as articulated by the Prime Minister. He added that the initiative "seeks to inspire collective youth action against addiction, while reinforcing the role of fitness and civic discipline in nation-building."

In a tighter moment during the launch, Milind

Soman invited participants to take part in a push-up challenge and take selfies with those who completed it. Amandeep Singh, National Media In-Charge, BJYM said the NaMo Yuva Run is part of a broader slate of programmes under Seva Pakhwada, observed annually to commemorate the birth anniversary of the Prime Minister. The campaign will be followed by further youth-focused initiatives spanning public health, environmental awareness, and community outreach, he said.
